Suggested Recipe to try

*Recipe: Mars bar Biscuits



Makes around 16 pieces

Ingredients 6- 7

Mars Bars (Milky Way bars) 200g

Butter 200g

Rice Krispies 300g

Chocolate (Good Quality)

Method

1. Line a 92 x 13 2 or a 30cm x 20 cm baking tin with parchment paper.
2. Cut the Mars bars and butter into small pieces and place in a saucepan. Place over low heat and stir until melted, taking care not to let it burn.
3. Add the Mars Bar mixture and Rice Krispies in a large bowl. Stir until ingredients are combined.
4. Spoon into a lined baking tin and press the mixture with the back of the spoon to firm up the shape.
5. Melt good quality chocolate over a saucepan of simmering water. Pour over the contents of the tin, spread evenly with a palette knife and leave to set.
6. When the chocolate is firm and cool, lift the contents of the tin to a cutting board and slice them into squares.
7. Ready to serve. Enjoy!
