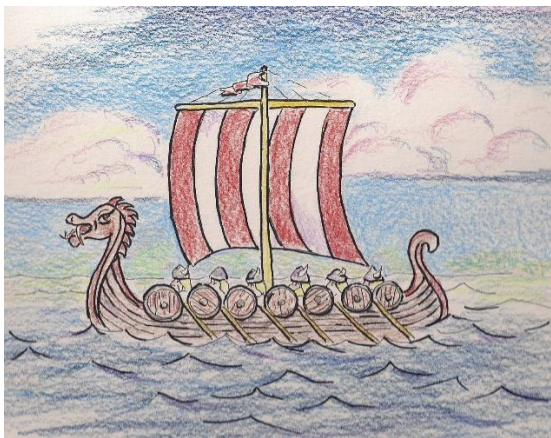

Suggested Recipe to try

***Recipe to try: Coffee or Lemon Squares**

Ingredients:

8oz self-raising flour

60z butter/margarine

6oz castor sugar

3 eggs

1 tsp baking powder

1 tablespoon coffee essence or grated zest of 1 large lemon

Method:

1. Heat the oven to 180 degrees and combine all ingredients using an electric mixer. Spread the cake mixture evenly out into a buttered swiss roll tin and cook for 20 minutes. Leave to cool.
2. For lemon squares - Make a glaze by mixing the juice of your lemon with 3 1/2oz caster sugar. While your cake is still warm, prick the top all over with a cocktail stick and pour the glaze over. It will get nice and crunchy as it cools.
3. For coffee squares - make icing by combining 3 1/2 oz soft butter, 7oz icing sugar and 3 teaspoons coffee essence or black coffee. Wait the cake has cooled completely before putting icing on.
4. Cut into squares and enjoy!
