

Suggested Recipe to try

*Recipe: Scones



Preparation time: 15 minutes

Cook time: 10 minutes **Total time:** 25 minutes

Ingredients

- 225g self-raising flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 150ml milk
- 50g butter or margarine
- 25g caster sugar

- Milk/egg for brushing (glazing)
- 6-7cm scone cutter (or a cup)
- Optional ingredient: 50g fruits (sultanas, raisins, etc,)

Adult help/ supervision may be needed to use oven.

Method

- 1. Put the oven/ preheated oven 220°C.
- 2. Grease two baking trays.
- 3. Sieve the flour, salt and baking powder into a bowl and stir in sugar if used.
- 4. Cut up the butter or margarine and add to flour.
- 5. Rub in butter or margarine. Add sultanas or raisins.
- 6. Add sufficient milk to make soft dough.
- 7. Sprinkle some flour onto your work surface and put dough on it. Knead to remove any cracks.
- 8. Roll the dough until 1cm thick. Cut the dough into circles with scone cutter.
- 9. Put on a floured baking tray and glaze (brush) with beaten egg or milk.
- 10. Bake the scones in a preheated oven 220°C/425°F/Gas 8 on top shelf of the oven for 10 mins approx. Enjoy with butter, jam or even whipped cream!

(* means optional task)
