# **Recipe**

#### **Optional Task**

For <u>Pancake Tuesday or Shrove Tuesday</u> why not make some pancakes.

#### **Recipe: Pancakes**



#### Ingredients

- 100g plain flour
- 300ml milk
- 2 eggs
- 1tbsp caster sugar
- Lemon juice

#### Equipment

- Sifter
- Large mixing bowl
- Kitchen scales
- Measuring jug
- Measuring spoons
- Wooden spoon
- Frying pan
- Spatula
- Stove/ cooker

#### Adult help/ supervision may be needed to use cooker.

#### Method

- 1. Sieve the flour into the mixing bowl.
- 2. Crack the eggs into the bowl.
- 3. Pour the milk into the bowl.
- 4. Stir vigorously until smooth.
- 5. Pour a spoonful of the mixture into a hot frying pan (you may want to use oil).
- 6. Turn the pancake when the bubbles begin to pop.
- 7. Serve sprinkled with lemon juice and sugar.
