Link – Japan and Procedural Writing

Recipe: Fun Sushi Balls



Ingredients:

- 1 cup sushi rice
- 2 tablespoon sushi seasoning
- 95g canned tuna
- 2 tablespoon mayonnaise
- ½ avocado
- **Optional ingredient:** 1 sheet nori seaweed

Method:

1. With damp hands, cup approximately 1/4 cup of rice in one hand. Place some tuna and a piece of avocado in the centre.
2. Top with another 1/4 cup of rice and gently bring it together into a ball shape. Press firmly to enclose.
3. **Optional step:** Using sharp scissors, cut shapes from the nori. Press onto balls to decorate.
4. Serve with sushi seasoning and mayonnaise to dip.
