4. There are 260 different types of monkeys!!


3. Monkeys tend to live in the tropical rainforests of Africa, Central America, South America and Asia!

1. Leopards, jaguars, cougars, some species of eagles and birds of prey, snakes such as pythons all like to eat monkeys.




