- Christmas Cards this year again our Parents Association in conjunction with Christmas Cards for Schools, are offering the children, with your consent, an opportunity to design their own Christmas card. A consent note is attached and needs to be returned immediately to allow the orders to be placed prior to midterm. Please complete the details, scan and email back to the school email address ballinamucknschool@gmail.com This is a fundraising event by the PA which in turn allows them to run activities in the school such as the Easter Egg Hunt etc.

- <u>Swimming lessons</u> resume on the <u>Wednesday 3rd November 2021</u> at 11.30am to 12.15pm (subject to any re-introduction of restrictions at this point), for children in <u>3rd to 6th</u> class only and will run for a period of 6 weeks. Two buses have been organised to keep children in their classroom groups while travelling. A consent note, which requires your signature to allow your child to take part is attached. Please complete the details, sign, and return to the school email address, already included above. The cost per child will be €40 and for two children €75 and this will be set up on the Way2Pay system shortly. Please confirm consent and pay the required monies by <u>Friday 29th October 2021.</u>
- <u>Healthy Eating Week</u> On Monday 8th November, in conjunction with Food Dudes, we will be running a healthy eating week. Like in previous years Food Dudes will provide each child with 5 days complementary fresh fruit and vegetables and exciting optional activities for each class to celebrate our healthy eating week. The objective of this week is to reinforce our Healthy Eating Policy and we ask all parents/guardians to be cognisance/ mindful of this when preparing school lunches/snacks. (One treat is allowed on Fridays)
- <u>Maths Week –</u> commences on Monday 18th October with the objective of encouraging the children to engage more in maths activities at home and at school in a fun and active way.
- <u>Christmas Annuals -</u> While we may not like to think about it just yet we already have the
 Christmas Annuals in. The deadline for ordering will be mid-November and the cost will be
 roughly the same as last year. More details post mid- term break.
