Our Updated Homework Policy was ratified at the last Board of Management meeting on the 19th February and is visible on our school website. A completed draft of our Bí Cineálta (Anti-Bullying) policy was completed by our staff during the recent school half-day closure. The policy has been circulated to the Parents Association and will be communicated to the Board of Management for further considerations before ratification at the next Board meeting. A survey in relation to the Hot School Meals Programme was sent out through our Aladdin App. Please complete to help us with our review.

The Annual review of our Risk Assessment document as part of our Child Protection Policy will begin shortly. A google form document will be sent out through Aladdin. We are exploring different avenues to improve the current car parking arrangements. Tree damage caused by storm Éowyn has presented some safety concerns. We are working closely with the local community and our insurance company to remedy damage caused.

Colm Bannon of Oide (Teacher Professional Development Body) visited our school last Thursday to work with myself and Mrs.Kenny on our Digital Learning Plan. Colm also talked us through the setting up of new google workspace email accounts in keeping with best practice as regards GDPR. Our new school email is officeballinamuckns.ie. Well done to all the children who are representing our school in Scór. Thank you to Ms.Mulligan for preparing the children so well and to all parents for lending their support.

The qualifiers for FAI Schools Primary 5s will take place on 5th March in Longford Rugby Club. Cumann na mBunscol Championship fixtures will commence on the week beginning 24th March. In conjunction with Cumann na Mbunscol, we will be taking part in a football mini-7s tournament in Newtownforbes on Tuesday 11th March. Children from 3rd to 6th class will be representing our school at the Longford Athletics Day in St.Mel's Athletic Centre on Wednesday 12th March.

As part of seachtain na gaeilge, children from 1st and 2nd class will be visiting Drumlish Library this Thursday, 6th March. Author, Sadhbh Devlin will be facilitating a workshop based on the book 'An Fia Sa Choill'. An Fia sa Choill is a retelling of a Fionn Mac Cumhaill myth. Sadhbh waves her magic wand and the children turn into animals. They draw themselves as their chosen animal but must include a secret clue so that we can recognise who they really are.
