Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you all very much for supporting our fantastic Bake Sale which is one of the highlights on our school calendar each year. The 5th and 6th class children did an amazing job of organising and running the event. This year a total of \leq 1,062.20 was raised. Money raised will go towards covering the following; trip to the Dáil (5th/6th), outlay spent on our garden this spring/summer, and dance lessons with Chloe Brady this Thursday.

Fourteen solar panels were fitted on our general purpose hall on May 22nd.. Associated electrical works were carried out on May 26th. In total the Department of Education funded €7,000 to cover works completed.

Our new Bí Cinéalta Policy (Anti-Bullying) was ratified at our Board of Management meeting on Wednesday 28th May. The Bí Cinéalta Policy will be effective from the start of the next school year. The risk assessment document as part of our child safeguarding statement was also reviewed. Discussions about how to improve our current car parking arrangements are ongoing.
